Gordon Strachan, an aide to H. R. Haldeman when Mr. Haldeman was White House chief of staff in the Nixon Administration, has been given approval for admission to the bar in Utah. The state Supreme Court voted, 3 to 1, in favor of Mr. Strachan's application because he passed the bar examinations "and has been recommended by the Utah state bar as being of good moral character and qualified to act as an attorney." Mr. Strachan was indicted with Mr. Haldeman and John D. Ehrlichman on charges on conspiracy and obstruction of justice in the Watergate Coverup. Charges against him were discoverup.
