## **Agnew Selling Home**

Spiro T. Agnew's home is up for sale.

The former vice president said Tuesday that he is buying a house under construction in Palm Springs (Riverside county) and plans to move in early April. Agnew announced last fall that he and his wife, Judy, were leaving the house in Annapolis they had lived in since June, 1974.

Colin F. McGowan, who built and sold the house to the Agnews, said the asking price for the four-bedroom, colonial style, brick and clapboard home was between \$150,000 and \$185,000. He said Agnew paid between \$100,000 and \$150,000 for it.

Agnew, who resigned the vice presidency October 10, 1973, and pleaded no contest to an income tax charge, said he will keep the Crofton, Md., office of his consulting firm, Pathlite Inc., and open another in California.
