Dean Cancels Lecture Tour

John Dean, former President Nixon's White House counsel, announced he is cancelling his lecture tour because of what Nixon said during the David Frost interviews, television station KNXT reported last night.

Reporter Bill Stout said Dean

sent a telegram to schools on his lecture tour, including several in Georgia and Ohio where talks were scheduled this week and next, after watching the first in a series of Nixon-Frost interviews Wednesday night.

In the telegram, Stout report-

ed, Dean said there was no way he "could have known Mr. Nixon would raise matters resulting in my completely re-examining some events that transpired during his presidency."
