

Sirhan to Tell Panel: No Conspiracy

Convicted assassin Sirhan Sirhan has agreed to end eight years of silence about the murder of Robert Kennedy to tell officials that he knows of no conspiracy to kill the senator, Sirhan's lawyer said yesterday.

"Sirhan knows of no conspiracy and knows of no conspirators," Godfrey Isaac said.

After eight years of silence about the assassination, Sirhan accepted a request by county supervisors Baxter Ward and Kenneth Hahn to tell what he knows. The meeting will take place at Soledad Prison, where Sirhan is serving a life sentence, probably within the next few weeks, officials said.
