Thousands to Tour Nixon's Estate

Eight thousands visitors are expected here this weekend — all of them hoping for a glimpse of the town's most mysterious resident, Richard Nixon.

The former President and his wife, Pat, who live in seclusion at their seaside villa, have agreed to open the grounds of their estate for a one-time only public bus tour.

The tour is the main event in the celebration of San Clemente's 50th birthday, and it has drawn a sellout crowd.

Then, tomorrow, the gate to La Casa Pacifica will open to the public for the first time since the Nixons moved in.

Tourists have paid \$2.50 apiece for the privilege of boarding buses which will take them on a seven-minute ride through the grounds of the estate once known as the Western White House.

Security will be tight and no one will be allowed off the buses during the tour.
