Nixon's Having A Party

The editor of Richard Nixon's "Memoirs" said yesterday that the former President will play host for a publishing party at his San Clemente estate on May 21.

Among those scheduled to attend are the editor, Robert Markel of Grosset & Dunlap, publisher Harold Roth, and two executives of Warner Books, which paid Nixon a reported \$2 million for rights to his autobiography.

The \$19.95 book is to be published on May 15.

Nixon also has invited former U.S. prisoners of war to his home May 27 during their commemoration in nearby Los Angeles of the fifth anniversary of their release from North Vietnam.
