

San Jose Suit Against Nixon

Two women filed a lawsuit in San Jose yesterday against former President Richard Nixon, alleging he is illegally making profits on things he did while in office.

The suit was filed on behalf of Juanita Anderson of Fremont and Madge Van Horn of San Jose, both of whom described themselves as community activists.

They said they had started a non-profit organization called People Against PORN, the ini-

tials standing for "Profits of Richard Nixon."

The complaint, filed in Santa Clara county Superior Court, was prepared by attorney A. Lee Sanders of San Jose.

The action asks that Nixon pay \$1.3 million and 20 percent of his net worth to the federal treasury as compensation to U.S. taxpayers for his involvement in Watergate.

Recently Nixon published his memoirs of office in a book that sells for \$19.95, and is being carried in various newspapers in a syndicated serialization.
