

Asks U. S. To Curb Rep. Dies

LOS ANGELES — The United States Government was urged to dissolve the Dies Committee because of its attacks against peace organizations, organized labor, and for not conducting serious investigations into the activities of the Ku Klux Klan and Vigilantes (California's very special brand of kluxers) by the Dining Car Employees, Local 465, of the Union Pacific system in a special resolution sent to Attorney Frank Murphy this week.

In addressing the second biennial convention of Dining Car Waiters here, General Secretary Rufus C. Long, who reported for the resolutions committee, advocated that the body go on record as condemning any drive against the Bill of Rights and all violations of American Civil Liberties.
