
 Joachim Joesten is the champion Warren Report critic, having turned out seven books on the subject thus far. And there will be more.

Three more books have been announced, but they will not be available at bookstores or newsstands. By summer Joesten will have ready a two-volume work entitled THE CASE AGAINST LYNDON B. JOHNSON. The first volume will deal with "his role in the plot before the murder" and the second "his role in the cover-up."

During World War Two Joesten was an assistant editor of Newsweek. Since then he has written books and magazine articles.

A second book will also be ready soon. It will be called THE CASE AGAINST THE KENNEDY CLAN ("They've known the truth all along—but cowardice and expediency kept them quiet."). The third title is THE BIGGEST LIE EVER TOLD (The Kennedy Murder Fraud—and how I helped expose it), which is in four volumes.
