

Jackie Book Trial Set

NEW YORK — (AP) — Mrs. John F. Kennedy's suit to block publication of the book, "The Death of a President," was scheduled today for trial on Jan. 18.

Attempts to reach an out-of-court settlement and avert a trial were continuing, however. In setting the trial date, State Supreme Court Justice Saul S. Streit told newsmen:

"Negotiations have not

been completed. They are being continued."

Mrs. Kennedy is seeking a permanent injunction against publication by Harper & Row, publishers of the book.

Previously, Mrs. Kennedy reached an out-of-court agreement with Look magazine, which holds serial rights to the book.

Look begins its four-part, 60,000-word serialization of the book in the issue that hits newsstands next Tuesday.
