- 1:30 pm - President Kennedy and Gov. John Connally of Texas shot in Dallas.
- 2:00 pm - President Kennedy is dead.
- 2:15 pm - Dallas patrolman J.D. Tippit is slain.
- 2:38 pm - Lyndon B. Johnson sworn in as 36th President of the United States.
- 3:00 pm - Lee Harvey Oswald arrested in movie theatre.
- 6:03 pm - President Kennedy's body returned to Washington, D.C.
- 8:15 pm - Oswald arraigned in death of patrolman Tippit.

Saturday, Nov. 23

- 2:30 am - Oswald arraigned in death of President Kennedy.
- 4:25 am - President Kennedy's body in East Room of the White House.
- 8:55 am - President Johnson begins first day as President.
- 10:00 am - President Kennedy's body lies in repose.
- 10:30 am - Mrs. Kennedy and children, Caroline and John Jr., attend private Mass in East Room.
- 1:21 pm - President Johnson proclaims Nov. 25 as day of national mourning.
- 4:51 pm - President Johnson makes first formal address, repeating proclamation.
- 6:00 pm - Period of repose for body of President Kennedy ends.
- 9:15 pm - President Johnson ends first full day in White House.

Sunday, Nov. 24

- 12:20 pm - Oswald shot in Dallas City Hall jail.
- 1:00 pm - Caisson bearing body of President Kennedy is drawn in formal procession from White House to Capitol Rotunda to lie in state.
- 2:07 pm - Oswald is dead.
- 4:23 pm - Jack Ruby, 52, Dallas night club owner, charged in death of Oswald.
