

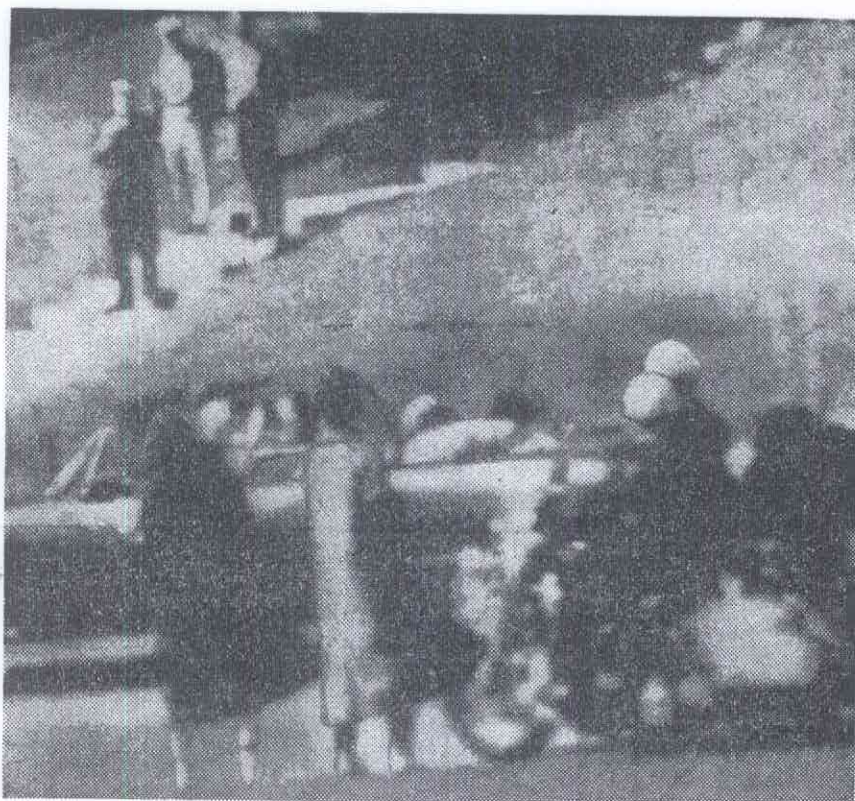
Colored film of shooting in Life memorial edition, credited to "a Dallas clothing manufacturer", are taken from opposite side of the street.

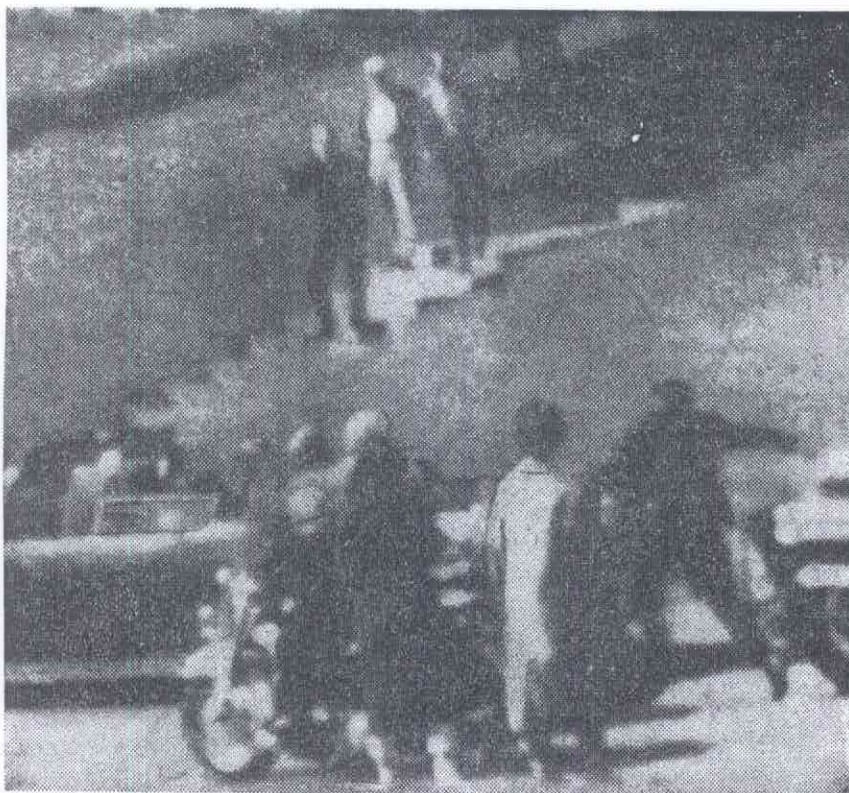
## A Camera on The Murder
