Reveal Suspect's Brother

SAN ANTONIO—(AP)—The Air Force reported today that Lee Harvey Oswald, accused of killing President John F. Kennedy in Dallas a week ago, has a half-brother with a good military record stationed here.

He is Sgt. John E. Pic, a laboratory technician at the Wilford Hall Air Force Hospital at Lackland Air Force Base.

He is buying a home, authorities said, and has three children—10, 6 and 3.

In 11 years, Sgt. Pic has seen Oswald only once, the Air Force quoted Pic as saying.

The sergeant told military authorities of the family tie immediately on hearing that Oswald had been ar-

rested, the Air Force said.

The hospital commander, Brig. Gen. J. W. Humphreys Jr., said:

"It is my understanding that appropriate federal agencies have investigated Sgt. Pic and it appears that he is cleared of any possible connection with Friday's crime."

The hospital declined to

release a picture.

Initial official statements did not say whether Pic's father was alive.
