DALLAS JULY 2 (AP)-FORMER DALLAS MAYOR EARLE CABELL AND HIS WIFE YESTERDAY DISCLOSED A STORY OF DEATH THREATS WHICH PROMPTED CONSTANT POLICE PROTECTION FOR TWO MONTHS AFTER PRESIDENT KENNEDY WAS SHOT.

THE POLICE GUARD BEGAN NOV.24, THE DAY ACCUSED ASSASSIN LEE HARVEY OSWALD WAS SHOT BY JACK RUBY.

CABELL WAS SCHEDULED TO FLY TO WASHINGTON, D.C., TO ATTEND THE PRESIDENT'S FUNERAL THE SAME DAY. BUT CITY HALL RECEIVED A LONG DISTANCE CALL SAYING AN ATTEMPT WOULD B MADE ON THE MAYOR'S LIFE, AND AT THE ADVICE OF POLICE CHIEF JESSE CURRY HE TOOK A LATER FLIGHT UNDER AN ASSUMED NAME.

IN JANUARY, THE CABELLS WERE HOSTS FOR A NEW YEAR'S PARTY AT THEIR HOME. ABOUT 30 MINUTES BEFORE MIDNIGHT, CABELL SAID, A "MATURE AND OSTENSIBLY SOBER" VOICE TELEPHONED AND TOLD MRS. CABELL:

"THIS IS THE NIGHT WE ARE GOING TO GET THE MAYOR."

THEN THE LIGHTS IN THE FRONT OF THE HOUSE WENT OUT.

CABELL AND TWO DETECTIVES RACED TO THE GARAGE WHERE THE CIRCUIT BREAKER WAS LOCATED, BUT FOUND NO ONE.

THE POLICE PROTECTION ENDED JAN.21 SEVERAL WEEKS AFTER THE THREATENING CALLS CEASED.
