Dallas, July 3, 1968 (AP)- Dist. Atty. Henry Wade says he believes the Warren commission investigating the assassination of President Kennedy has no doubts where the fatal shots ~~xxxxxx~~ were fired from.

"We had a number of people -- about a dozen, I recall -- who said they saw the gun in the window of the depository building," the prosecutor said yesterday.

Several, he added, said they saw a man holding the weapon.

Wade speculated this was why commission investigators did not question Mrs. Earl Cabell, wife of the former Dallas mayor, who said this week she also saw the gun last Nov. 22.
