PERSONS WERE TURNED AWAY FROM THE CATHEDRAL 10 MINUTES BEFORE THE SERVICE.

ASSISTING IN THE MASS WAS THE REV. OSCAR L. HUBER, THE 71-YEAR-OLD PRIEST WHO ADMINISTERED THE LAST RITES TO PRESIDENT KENNEDY NOV. 22, 1963.

EARLIER, FATHER HUBER RECALLED PERHAPS THE MOST MEMORABLE DUTY OF HIS LIFETIME.

"I WENT TO THE EMERGENCY ROOM, AND SAW THE PRESIDENT LYING ON A TABLE," HE SAID. "THE DOCTORS HAD GIVEN UP HOPE AND STOOD THERE ABOUT TO LEAVE. THE PRESIDENT WAS COVERED WITH A WHITE SHEET DOWN TO JUST BELOW HIS KNEES, AND ALL I COULD SEE WAS THE WHITENESS OF HIS FEET.

"I PULLED THE SHEET DOWN TO HIS NOSE TO ANNOINT HIS HEAD WITH OIL. HE WAS APPARENTLY DEAD, SO I ADMINISTERED ONLY THE CONDITIONAL LAST RITES TO ASK GOD TO RECEIVE HIS SOUL.

"HIS EYES WERE CLOSED. HE SEEMED TO BE JUST A MAN ASLEEP," THE PRIEST SAID.

IN ANOTHER SERVICE, TWO UNIFORMED POLICEMEN PLACED A WREATH AT THE GRAVE OF PATROLMAN J.D. TIPPIT, KILLED IN THE SEARCH FOR KENNEDY'S ASSASSIN. THEN TIPPIT'S WIDOW WALKED TO A POLICE SQUAD CAR, SAT ALONE AND WEPT.

IN A DALLAS HOSPITAL LAY MARINA OSWALD, THE ASSASSIN'S WIDOW WHO HAS BEEN A PATIENT SEVERAL DAYS WITH A STOMACH DISORDER. MRS. OSWALD WAS DESCRIBED BY A SPOKESMAN AS "FEELING VERY SORRY FOR MRS. KENNEDY AND HER CHILDREN."

AT NEARBY FORT WORTH, TEX., MRS. MARGUERITE OSWALD, WHO HAS REPEATEDLY PROCLAIMED THE INNOCENCE OF HER SON IN THE ASSASSINATION, REMAINED INDOORS. SHE SAID SHE WAS AFRAID "SOME CRANKS" MIGHT BE OUT.

AT PARKLAND HOSPITAL, ADMINISTRATOR ROBERT DUTTON PLACED A WREATH ON THE DOOR OF TRAUMA ROOM ONE, WHERE THE PRESIDENT DIED, AND CLOSED IT FOR THE DAY.

DALLAS HAD ANOTHER VISITOR YESTERDAY.

GEORGE LINCOLN ROCKWELL, COMMANDER OF THE AMERICAN NAZI PARTY, WAS HERE TO ANNOUNCE THE FORMATION OF A NEW NAZI UNIT WITH 47 CHARTER MEMBERS.

ROCKWELL CREDITED WHAT HE TERMED "UNJUST BLAME HEAPED UPON DALLAS BY DALLAS JEWS" FOR THE LARGE NAZI GROUP HERE. HE TIMED THE ANNOUNCEMENT WITH THE ANNIVERSARY OF KENNEDY'S DEATH, HE SAID, BECAUSE "THE ASSASSINATION WAS A HIGH WATER MARK OF COMMUNIST TERROR IN THE COUNTRY."

DALLAS-JFK (500)

DALLAS NOV. 23 (AP)—JOHN F. KENNEDY VISITED DALLAS AGAIN YESTERDAY. HIS BLACK LIMOUSINE TURNED LEFT OFF HOUSTON STREET ONTO ELM BENEATH THE TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY, AND AGAIN THE BULLETS WERE IN THE AIR AND AGAIN THE PRESIDENT DIED IN DALLAS.

IT HAPPENED JUST AS SURELY AS THE SKY WAS A BRILLIANT BLUE AND THE TEMPERATURE A CRISP 45 DEGREES AND THE TIME FLASHING 12:30 P.M. ON THE BIG CLOCK ATOP THE DEPOSITORY BUILDING.

A CROWD OF 200, PERHAPS 300 PERSONS STOOD IN THE CHILLING AIR TO RELIEVE THE ASSASSINATION ON ITS FIRST ANNIVERSARY.

FACES UPTURNED, THEY SPOKE QUIETLY AS THE CLOCK FLASHED 12:30 P.M. HANDS POINTED TOWARD THE DEPOSITORY'S SIXTH FLOOR WINDOW WHERE LEE HARVEY OSWALD HID, AND TO THE STREET WHERE THE PRESIDENT SAT A TARGET.

AT 1 P.M., THE MOMENT KENNEDY DIED IN PARKLAND HOSPITAL ONE YEAR AGO YESTERDAY, THERE WAS SILENCE AND STILLNESS, AS MAYOR ERIK JONSSON HAD REQUESTED FOR A SIGN OF PUBLIC RESPECT.

A POLICEMAN STEPPED INTO THE STREET, RAISED A GLOVED HAND AND HALTED TRAFFIC FOR ONE MINUTE. A TALL, MIDDLE-AGED MAN, NOT QUITE SURE WHAT HE SHOULD DO, REMOVED HIS HAT.

HUNDREDS AND PERHAPS THOUSANDS THROGGED THROUGHOUT THE DAY TO THE SITE.

THEY CAME AT DAWN AND AS LATE AS 10:30 P.M., WHEN ONE MAN USING A FLASHLIGHT ADDED HIS WREATH TO THE DOZENS OF REMEMBRANCES.

CHURCHES WERE FILLED FOR MEMORIAL SERVICES. POSSIBLY THE LARGEST WAS AT SACRED HEART CATHOLIC CATHEDRAL, ATTENDED BY PROTESTANTS, CATHOLICS AND JEWS.

"AT THE GOING DOWN OF THE SUN AND IN THE MORNING, LET US REMEMBER HIM," SAID THE RT. REV. MSGR. WILLIAM F. O'BRIEN.
