Unable to identify the paper package supposed to have sontained the gun. Described the package he had seen as fitting under the armpit when the lower end was cupped in Oswald's right hand. Frazier, who described himself as just over six feet tall, demonstrated that the package shown him extended nearly to his ear when held cupped in his hand as Oswald had held it.
