Instruction from Dispatcher H.D. Henslee to Ptn C.E. Whitman:
Contact 9 (Inspector J.H. Sawyer) and notify him they are holding up
a north-bound freight train there in the yard and they want to shake
it down before they let it go. Do you want to send some officers
over there to shake it down?

Between 1:57 and 1:59 p.m.

Ptn G.W. Temple and Ptn R.E. Vaughn to Dispatchers C.E. Hulse and J.A. McDaniel:

We have information from the agent out here at T&P. Said that the train is stopped on the overpass; that there was a person jumping at the ninth boxcar from the front engine. Said he is hiding in a car. Dispatcher:

Is the train stopped there now?

Temple and Vaughn:

I'm in behind the Texas School Depository. He has the train stopped. He said it is the ninth car from the engine. Gondola type car; said he is hunkered down inside.
