Copy of telegram supposedly sent by Oswald to Secretary of the Navy "several days" before date of report by C.A. Hamblen (Western Union, Dallas), 2 Dec 63. WR gives date as "about two weeks earlier" than 2 Dec. 63. Telegram is accounted for in cash sheet of Mrs. D.J. McClure, whom Hamblen says handled transaction. Mrs. McClure denies that the incident occurred.
