Testimony of Sgt. Patrick Dean, Dallas, Mar. 24, 1964.

Said he had received a long distance call "last night", 2 a.m., from Victoria, B.C. Caller said his name was Ralph Simpson, that he had movie footage taken through wide scope movie camera which he thought "would have taken in/TSBD/ and motorcade at the time shots were fired". Said film had not been developed; would send it airmail to Dean.
