Harry D. Holmes - (after the shots) "people went from every direction hunting around the railroad yard and among the cars parked in the area."

Ronnie Dugger - "Through the windows /of press car/ we saw people breaking and running down Elm Street in the direction of the underpass, and running to the railing of the arch at the foot of the downtown section and leaping out of our sight onto the grass beyond and below ... " (Columbia Journalism Review, Winter, 1964, p. 6.)

Harold Feldman - Of 121 witnesses, 38 had no clear opinion, 32 thought they came from TSBD. 51 held the shots sounded as if they came from west of the Depository, the area of the grassy knoll. (Minority of One, March 1965, p. 16.)
