U.S. Judge Bars Release of Kopechne Transcript

BOSTON, April 14—A Fedreal judge ordered a temporary delay today in publication of the transcript of the Mary Jo Kopechne inquest, pending a decision on a suit brought by the inquest stenographers.

The restraining order, issued by United States District Court Judge Andrew A. Caffrey, does not apply to the report of Judge James A. Boyle, who presided at the January inquest. The judge's 12-page report will be released at 11 A.M. tomorrow in Suffolk Superior Court.
