Kennedy Takes Son From Dublin Hospital

Senator Edward M. Kennedy picked up his 12-year-old son at a Dublin hospital yesterday and drove with him to western Ireland for a quiet vacation.

"We're looking forward to a few days in the countryside," the senator said at the door of St. Vincent's Hospital. "Teddy is anxious to rejoin his friends."

Young Kennedy was treated here for side effects from medication he has received since his right leg was amputated late last year to arrest bone cancer.

"There is no need for alarm" over the boy's condition, his doctor said yesterday.
