Mrs. Kennedy Will Not Appear At Convention

WASHINGTON (AP) — Mrs. John F. Kennedy will not attend the National Democratic Convention in August nor take any part in the fall political campaign, her press secretary said Tuesday.

Miss Pamela Turnure also said the wife of the late president has no plans at this time to vacation in Italy or Greece this year.

"Her only summer plans are to go to Newport, R.I.," Miss Turnure told a reporter. Mrs. Kennedy is now at Hyannis Port, Mass.

Miss Turnure noted that the campaign and election will fall within the one-year period of mourning which Mrs. Kennedy is observing for her husband.

Mrs. Kennedy announced last Dec. 12 that during the morning period she would have no public engagements.

Miss Turnure's statement Tuesday apparently was aimed at speculation that Mrs. Kennedy might appear at the Democratic convention as part of any drive to obtain the party's vice-presidential nomination for Atty. Gen. Robert F. Kennedy, brother of the late President.
