WASHINGTON, AUG. 15 (AP)-IN THE NEWS FROM WASHINGTON:

CHANGE OF HEART: MRS. JOHN F. KENNEDY HAS ACCEPTED AN INVITATION TO ATTEND A SPECIAL RECEPTION AUG. 27 FOR DELEGATES TO THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION, W. AVERELL HARRIMAN ANNOUNCED TODAY.

THE FORMER NEW YORK GOVERNOR AND HIS WIFE WILL BE HOSTS AT THE RECEPTION, BEING HELD AS AN APPRECIATION TO THOSE WHO SUPPORTED THE AIMS OF THE LATE PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY AT THE 1960 DEMOCRATIC CONVENTION.

MRS. KENNEDY IS NOW VACATIONING IN EUROPE. LAST MONTH HER PRESS SECRETARY, MISS PAMELA TURNURE, SAID MRS. KENNEDY WOULD NOT ATTEND THE CONVENTION OR TAKE ANY PART IN THE CAMPAIGN.

THE CAMPAIGN AND THE ELECTION, SAID MISS TURNURE THEN, WILL FALL WITHIN THE ONE-YEAR PERIOD OF MOURNING WHICH MRS. KENNEDY IS OBSERVING FOR HER HUSBAND.
