PAMELA TIMMINS, MRS. KENNEDY'S PRESS SECRETARY, SAID REPORTS THAT THE FORMER FIRST LADY HAD OBTAINED A CAMBODIAN VISA ARE INCORRECT.

"SHE APPLIED FOR A CAMBODIAN VISA SEVERAL MONTHS AGO WHEN SHE WAS THINKING ABOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF GOING ON A TRIP THERE," MRS. TIMMINS SAID. "BUT THERE WERE NEVER ANY DEFINITE PLANS, AND NOW MRS. KENNEDY ISN'T EVEN THINKING ABOUT IT ANY MORE.
