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NEW YORK, MARCH 28 (AP)-MRS. JOHN F. KENNEDY AND HER TWO CHILDREN RETURNED HOME TODAY, CUTTING SHORT A VACATION IN ACAPULCO.

APPARENTLY SHE HAD BEEN DISTURBED BY NEWSMEN AND PHOTOGRAPHERS AT THE SWANK MEXICAN RESORT.

A TIGHT SECURITY GUARD WAS PROVIDED ON THEIR ARRIVAL AT KENNEDY AIRPORT. THEY LEFT IN A LIMOUSINE WHICH HAD BEEN DRIVEN ONTO A RAMP NEXT TO THE AIRPLANE.

THE KENNEDYS WENT TO ACAPULCO MARCH 17 AND HAD PLANNED TO STAY ABOUT TWO WEEKS.

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NEWSMEN AND PHOTOGRAPHERS DOGGED HER STEPS, DESPITE SECURITY PRECAUTIONS, AND ON ONE OCCASION, SHE AND HER DAUGHTER, CAROLINE, WERE DUMPED INTO THE PACIFIC AND THEIR SMALL SAILBOAT WAS OVERTURNED BY WAVES FROM A POLICE LAUNCH CHASING A BOATLOAD OF PHOTOGRAPHERS.

MRS. KENNEDY WAS ACCOMPANIED ON THE FLIGHT NORTH BY HER CHILDREN, CAROLINE AND JOHN JR., HER SISTER LEE RADZIWILL, AND LEE'S HUSBAND, PRINCE STANISLAW RADZIWILL AND THEIR CHILDREN.

MRS. KENNEDY HAD BEEN STAYING AT THE HOME OF MEXICAN ARCHITECT FERNANDO PARRA HERNANDEZ, IN A CLOSED-OFF SECTION OF THE RESORT CITY.

MRS. KENNEDY HAD THREATENED TO LEAVE EARLIER BUT WAS PERSUADED TO STAY ON AFTER ASSURANCES THAT HER PRIVACY WOULD BE RESPECTED.

THE AREA WAS HEAVILY GUARDED BY SOLDIERS AND POLICE. BUT THE SECTION FACING THE SEA WAS OPEN, AND PHOTOGRAPHERS HIRED LAUNCHES AND BOATS AND SAILED CLOSE TO SHORE FOR PICTURES.

THE HOUSE IS IN THE PUERTO MARQUES SECTION, NOT FAR FROM A HOME OWNED BY FORMER MEXICAN PRESIDENT MIGUEL ALEMAN.

MRS. KENNEDY KEPT MAINLY TO THE HOME, BUT MADE A FEW TOURS OF ACAPULCO, ATTENDED A M

OF ACAPULCO, -ATTEND A MASS, MADE BOAT TOURS, AND REPORTEDLY WENT TO A BULLFIGHT.

A MEXICAN FISHERMAN, WHO HAD RENTED HIS BOAT TO PHOTOGRAPHERS, WAS ARRESTED WHEN HE CAME IN TOO CLOSE TO THE SHORE MARCH 18.

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
