

Kennedy Jr. Is Robbed In Park

John F. Kennedy Jr., 13, son of the late President, was robbed of his bicycle and a tennis racket Tuesday in Central Park by an older boy while on his way to a tennis lesson, it was disclosed yesterday. (14 MK)

He was not injured, according to a spokesman for the boy's mother, Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis.

The spokesman said a youth about 18 years old grabbed the bike and tennis racket from young Kennedy at 5 p.m. and rode off into the park.

A spokesman for the Secret Service in Washington said young Kennedy is under its protection but declined to comment on the incident. The New York field office referred inquiries to Washington.

Young Kennedy told police of the incident and was driven around the park in a patrol car but did not spot his assailant, the spokesman said.
