

Kennedy Bike Case Dropped

For the first time, John F. Kennedy Jr. failed to show up in court yesterday to testify against a young man accused of stealing a bicycle from the son of the late President in Central Park last May 14.

As a result, Judge Robert Haft dismissed charges of

robbery, grand larceny and criminal possession of stolen property against Robert Lopez, a 20-year-old admitted cocaine and heroin addict.

Young Kennedy has been vacationing with his mother and stepfather, Aristotle Onassis, on the Greek island of Skorpios.
