WASHINGTON AP - The White House said Saturday President Nixon
has approved plans to provide public access reutes to a
grave in Arlington National Cemetery for Robert F. Kennedy.
The Defense Department recommended a \$431,000 appropriation for
the project but former President Lynden B. Johnson omitted specific
mention of it in his budget and left the matter to his successor.
White House press secretary Ronald L Ziegler said Saturday Nixon
was aware of the project and is favorably disposed to the
