

Stunned Reaction In S.F.

The news that Senator Robert F. Kennedy had been shot created mass hysteria at his "victory" party at the California Hall here last night.

More than 100 of the 300 men and women in the hall began sobbing uncontrollably.

"It's all over now," said one pretty coed, tears running down her face.

A young Negro kicked over a blackboard on the stage, and another Negro man shouted angrily, "this god-damned white racism. . . !"

Assemblyman Willie Brown Jr. said he was "convinced" that the attempt on Senator Kennedy's life "is part of a conspiracy."

"First it was President Kennedy, then Martin Luther King, now Bobby Kennedy. This is not an isolated incident."
