

Legislative Delegation RFK Rites

SACRAMENTO — An 18 member delegation will represent the California Legislature at Senator Robert F. Kennedy's funeral in New York tomorrow.

Senator Milton Marks of San Francisco will be the only Republican member of the group, which includes eight Bay Area representatives.

Assembly Speaker Jesse M. Unruh of Inglewood, who was state chairman of Kennedy's winning California primary campaign, will head 11 lower house members and Alan Short of Stockton is chairman of the seven-man Senate contingent.

The others are: Senators George Moscone, San Francisco; Alfred Alquist, San Jose; Nicholas C. Petris, Oakland; Mervyn Dymally, Los Angeles, and James R. Mills, San Diego.
