Wounded Bystanders Recovering

Los Angeles

One of the five persons shot with Senator Robert F. Kennedy was discharged from the hospital yesterday and the remainder were reported recovering satisfactorily.

Going back to his home was Ira Goldstein, 19. He suffered a bullet wound in the left hip.

Recovering were Paul Schrade, 30, the United Auto Workers Union's regional director, and ABC network newsman William Weisel, 30, of Washington, D.C.

Both were reported in satisfactory condition although Schrade was still in the hospital's intensive care unit. Schrade suffered a scalp wound, Weisel one in the abdomen.

The fifth victim, Elizabeth Evans, of Saugus, was reported in "excellent" condition at another hospital where she was treated for a scalp wound.
