

# Conspiracy-- 'No Evidence So Far'

Washington

Attorney General Ramsey Clark said yesterday that the FBI is investigating every possible angle in the shooting of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, including the possibility of conspiracy.

But he added at a news conference, "according to information that I have at this moment, we have no evidence of conspiracy."

The attorney general said that the FBI clearly has the authority to conduct an investigation because of the 1968 civil rights act which specifically provides for protection of individuals exercising a wide range of civil rights including voting and running for office.

He said there was additional authority under the Voting Rights Act and even some authority under a much older law which he termed inadequate.
