

## 2 Sirhan Victims Still in Hospital

LOS ANGELES — (AP) Only two of the five persons wounded when an assassin's bullet felled Sen. Robert Kennedy remained hospitalized today.

Spokesmen at the Kaiser Foundation Hospital described as in good condition both Paul Schrade, 43, western regional director for the United Auto Workers Union,

and William Weisel, 30, of Washington, D.C., a unit manager for the American Broadcasting Co.

Schrade was wounded in the head.

Weisel, shot in the left side, expects to return to Washington later this week.

The others wounded were Elizabeth Evans, 43, of Saugus, Irwin Stroll, 17, of Los Angeles, and Ira Goldstein, 19, of Encino. All have returned home.
