
Court Crackdown On Yorty

Mayor Sam Yorty was served yesterday with a copy of a court order forbidding public officials, attorneys and witnesses from public discussion of Sirhan B. Sirhan's part in the slaying of Senator Robert F. Kennedy.

Yorty has spoken at length, on television and to reporters, about the case. He revealed that Sirhan had a notebook in which he allegedly had written that Kennedy must die by June 5.

Yorty, who now came under threat of contempt of court, was handed the court order in his office.

"The court order did not for some strange reason apply to newspapers," he said.
