
Lawyer Says Sirhan Still A Bit Nervous

Sirhan B. Sirhan, charged with the murder of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, remains in a "nervous" condition but no longer suffers from insomnia, his attorney said yesterday.

Russell E. Parsons said he had spent "the better part of two days" this week talking with the 24-year-old Jordanian immigrant in his jail cell preparing the defense for the trial scheduled to start November 1.

Parsons disclosed he had received a copy of a letter from county supervisor Kenneth Hahn recommending that the trial be postponed until after the November 5 presidential election because of the "tremendous emotional feeling" at that time.
