

Sirhan Curb May Be Eased

SAN QUENTIN, Calif., Jan 22 (AP)—San Quentin prison officials will review next month the possibility of easing security restrictions that keep Sirhan Sirhan in isolation from other prisoners on death row, Associate Warden James Park says. Sirhan, sentenced for the assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, ended a 13-day hunger strike Dec. 10.
