LOS ANGELES AP - Po-  
 lice ballistics expert DeWayne  
 Wolfer has filed a \$2 million de-  
 famation suit against an attor-  
 ney who accused Wolfer of er-  
 rors in his investigation of the  
 assassination of Sen. Robert F.  
 Kennedy.

Barbara Warner Blehr, a Los  
 Angeles lawyer, wrote last May  
 to city Civil Service Commis-  
 sion saying Wolfer had test-  
 fired a weapon other than the  
 one wrested from Sirhan Sir-  
 han, convicted Kennedy assas-  
 sin. Her letter sought to raise  
 the question whether a second  
 gunman might have fired at  
 Kennedy at a hotel here on  
 June 5, 1968.

Wolfer's attorney, John La-  
 Follette, told newsmen Friday  
 Mrs. Blehr had defamed  
 "anationally respected ballis-  
 tics expert." He said "every-  
 body conceded that only eight  
 bullets were fired; the Sirhan  
 gun contained eight bullets and  
 every one of them was fired."

Dist. Atty. Joseph Busch Jr.  
 ordered an investigation into  
 the questions raised by Mrs.  
 Blehr but has not announced  
 the results."
