

Hospital Releases Young Kennedy

Joseph P. Kennedy III was released from Herrick Memorial Hospital in Berkeley yesterday at 5:05 p.m. after apparently recovering from injuries suffered in an auto accident Saturday.

A hospital spokesman said Kennedy, 20, son of the late Senator Robert F. Kennedy, had suffered a mild concussion. X-rays showed he had no fractures.

The young Kennedy had

telephoned his mother Ethel, his uncle, Senator Ted Kennedy and his aunt Joan Kennedy before leaving, according to the spokesman.

There was no indication of his immediate plans.
