AT AN AIRPORT NEWS CONFERENCE, MRS. OSWALD WAS ACCOMPANIED BY MARK LANE, ATTORNEY SHE HAS SELECTED TO REPRESENT HER DEAD SON'S INTERESTS.

LANE SAID HE HAD DOCUMENTS TO INDICATE THAT SEVERAL PERSONS WERE INVOLVED IN THE ASSASSINATION PLOT. HE DESCRIBED THEM AS "PERSONS VERY DIFFERENT IN POLITICAL PHILOSOPHY" FROM OSWALD, WHO CALLED HIMSELF A MARKIST.

MRS. OSWALD, WHO RECENTLY TOLD AN INVESTIGATING COMMISSION HEADED BY CHIEF JUSTICE EARL WARREN THAT SHE BELIEVED HER SON WAS AN AGENT OF THE CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY, SAID TODAY SHE WAS PROUD OF HER SON FOR UNDERTAKING WHAT SHE TERMED A SECRET ASSIGNMENT. THE CIA HAS DENIED HE EVER WORKED FOR THE AGENCY.

SHE SAID LEE "STAYED AWAY FROM ALL OF US" WHILE WORKING AS A SECRET AGENT, ADDING: "I ADMIRE HIM FOR THAT."
