Belli Asks Rebuttal in Oswald Case

The Warren Commission has been asked by Attorney Melvin Belli to rebut statements by New York lawyer-lecturer Mark Lane on the assassination of President Kennedy.

-Belli, who was chief attorney for Jack Ruby when the Dallas night club owner was convicted of murdering Lee Harvey Oswald, made the request in a letter yesterday to Chief Justice Earl Warren.

Lane, according to Belli, "although a single, humble voice, has added immeasurabley to the calumnies about the events by 'proving' the innocence of Oswald and inferring the existence of sinister forces that the American people have not been told about."

Belli said from his close vantage point he was convinced that both Oswald and Ruby acted as individuals -"two lone aberrant indivduals.
