Mark Lane Marries Dane, Daughter of Businessman

NYKOEBING ¶ FALSTER, Denmark, Dec. 30 (Reuters) — Mark Lane, leader of the American Citizens' Committee of Inquiry into President Kennedy's assassination, was married today to the daughter of a Danish businessman.

Heavy snow on this South Danish island prevented both Mr. Lane and his 23-year-old bride, Anne-Lise Dabelsteen, from arriving on time at the 800-year-old church, where the ceremony was held.

Mr. Lane, a New York lawyer, had to walk the last mile to the church when his car skidded off an icy road into a ditch.

The couple first met when Mr. Lane was lecturing in Copenhagen about the assassination of President Kennedy.

Mr. Lane contends that Lee H. Oswald was not responsible for Mr. Kennedy's death.
