

## Film About The Kennedy Death Probe

The British Broadcasting Corp. has purchased a two-hour film challenging the work and findings of the Warren Commission on the assassination of President Kennedy.

Emil de Antonio, a co-producer of the film said that BBC had paid \$40,000 for the film.

He said the telecast in Britain would be on January 29 and theater showings would probably begin a few days earlier under separate negotiations.

The film, which cost \$68,000 to produce, is called "Rush to Judgment," and takes its title from the book by Mark Lane. Lane, the other co-producer, interviews 18 persons in the film, which he describes as "a brief for the defense."

Distribution of the film in the United States is still being negotiated.
