

The Warren Report Hit In a Film

Mannheim, Germany

A two-hour documentary film questioning the findings of the Warren Report on the assassination of President Kennedy had its world premiere here yesterday.

Entitled "Rush to Judgment," the American-produced film is based on the book of the same name by Attorney Mark Lane and is introduced by him as a defense argument for Lee Harvey Oswald. In it, Lane interviews witnesses whose testimony conflicts with the Warren Report and particularly disputes the conclusion that all shots fired at Kennedy came from the Dallas school book depository building.

Produced by Emile de Antonio, the documentary is designed for television rather than theater showing. It was presented in connection with Mannheim's annual festival for documentary films. De Antonio is negotiating with German and British television companies.
