Mark Lane on hilly Mose show, KNEW Oakland, tape #41-42. (Sony 104.)

- 200' Has received more than 100 death threats, some by phone, some by letter.
- 260' Four days previously had been told by Ruby's brother, in Chicago, that Ruby was not held in a cell but in a corridor over the psychiatric ward, where at night he could hear the patients screaming; could have been easy for prison guard to have suggested to kuby the screams were those of Jews being tortured.
- 322' Garrison has evidence that Ruby killed Oswald to silence him.
- 840' Does not believe that in all cases it was a "false Oswald."
- 880' Caller suggested that since CIA trains guerillas it must also train execution squads, and it would be ironical if they were the ones involved in the assassination. Lane's reply:

 "I know the answer to that but I cannot tell you."
- 1420' Lane's movie opened in New Orleans about two weeks previously in nine theaters; did well and had very good reviews. Difficulty in arranging for national distribution.
- 1490' Total he has made so far, \$2,600.
