

Jane Fonda Told She Will Face U.S. Grand Jury

Jane Fonda was told yesterday she will face a Federal grand jury on charges of illegally bringing about 2000 pills into the United States and attacking a federal customs agent.

The 32-year-old actress was bound over to the grand jury by Federal Commissioner Clifford E. Bruce during a preliminary hearing here.

Miss Fonda was arrested November 3, when about 2000 pills including amphetamines were found by customs agents in her luggage when she arrived here from Toronto.

The actress allegedly fought with a customs officer and a local policeman when she was told she would have to submit to a search by a matron.
