Warren Report Foe Heads New Group

Mark Lane, an indefatigable critic of the Warren Commission report, yesterday announced the formation here of the Citizens Commission of Inquiry, an unbrella organization designed to coordinate the activities of those who believe that Lee Harvey Oswald either did not kill President John F. Kenney, or was not working alone.

Lane, the director of the newly formed organization, said its purpose would be to generate "a nationwide organizing project to urge Congress to investigate the assassination of President John F. Kennedy and the resultant cover-up of the facts by the FBI and CIA."
