"I SAW THE EFFECTS OF THE THEND SHOP-THE SHOP TO THE HEAD-AND I ASSUMED THEM THERE WAS NO HOPE FOR HIM," COMMALLY SAID OF THE PRESIDENT'S ASSASSEMATION IN DALLAS NOV. 22.

COMMALLY SAXD WHEN HE HEARD THE FIRST STHO, HE HAD BUT ONE THOUGHT: "THES IS AN ASSASSEMATION ATTEMPT."

COMMALLY'S THOUGHTS DURING THAT HREEF PERIOD WHEM A SHEPER'S BULLETS GUT DOWN KENNEDY AND TORE THROUGH THE COVERNOR'S CHEST AS THE TWO OFFICIALS RODE IN A MOTORCADE WERE REVEALED AT THE AMBUAL ASSOCIATED PRESS TEXAS MANAGING EDITORS HEETING.

"FRANKLY, I THOUGHT I HAD BEEN KELLED TOO," SAID COMMALLY, HIS ARM STELL IN A SLINK FROM THE WOUNDS HE RECEIVED.

"THERE WAS NO PAIN WHATEVER, IT FELT LIKE A SHORT JAB TO THE BACK, I LINGED FORWARD, THERE WAS BLOOD EVERYWHERE AND HELLIE (MRS) CONNALLY) COVERED ME."

CONNALLY SAID HES TURNING TO CHECK ON THE PRESIDENT AFTER THE FIRST SHOT UNDOUBTEDLY SAVED HES LEFE.

THE LOOKED BACK OVER MY RIGHT SHOULDER AND COULDN'T SEE THE PRESEDENT, SO I TURNED TO LOOK OVER MY LEFT SHOULDER.

"I NEVER COMPLETED THAT SECOND TURN WHEN I COT HET, HAD I NOT TURNED, I HAVE NO DOUBLE THE BULLET WOULD HAVE ENTERED MY SPENE AND HEART."

COMMALLY'S STATEMENTS WERE MADE IN AN ANSWER TO A MUESTION OF WHEN HE FERST FELT THE IMPACT OF THE ASSASSINATION.

"EMMEDIATELY," THE GOVERNOR ANSWERED, THEM DESCRIBED HIS THOUGHTS.
THE QUESTION AND ANSWER PERIOD FOLLOWED FORMALLY'S ADDRESS TO THE
EDITORS, HIS PERST PUBLIC SPEECH SINCE HE WAS WOUNDED.

ALTHOUGH REMOEDY WAS SHOT TWICE, A RECENT MEDICAL REPORT IN THE TRACE STATE JOURNAL OF MEDICENCE REPORTED THE MASSIVE MEAD AND BRAIN THOURY CAUSED BY THE SE SECOND BILLET TO STRIKE HIM KEPT DOCTORS FROM PARRISHS A PARKY MEARD BACK TO LIVE.
