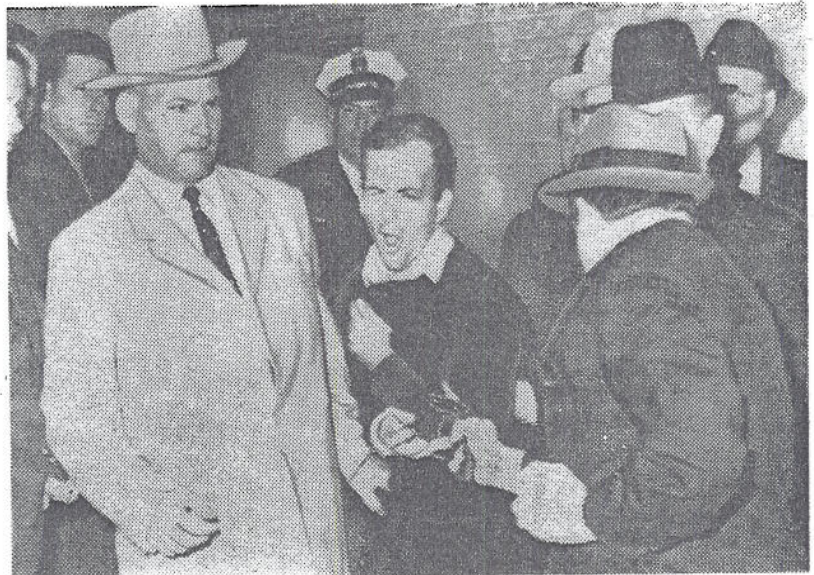
On the set of the BBC in London—a shooting re-enacted
